No. SOM(M&M)5-3/2007:- In exercise of the power conferred under section 2 of the Regulation of Mines and Oil-fields and Mineral Development (Government Control) Act, 1948 (XXIV of 1948) read with Rule 65 & 66 of the Punjab Mining Concession Rules, 2002 and in partial modification of Notification of even number dated 28.06.2013, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to determine rates of royalty of the minerals produced and carried away from the licensed or leased areas granted under Large Scale Mining with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2019, as follows: -

1.	Argillaceous clay	Rs.120 (Rupees one hundred and twenty only)
2.	Limestone	Rs.120 (Rupees one hundred and twenty only)
