

**Gravel Block Vehova-8, District Dera Ghazi Khan**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:**

This block of gravel over an area of 485.87 acres is located on VihowaRud (Nala) near BastiVihowa in Tehsil Tounsa, District Dera Ghazi Khan that is easily accessibly after travelling a distance of 10 km on non-metaled road from Vehova village leading toward VehovaNala and falls on topo sheet 39 I/8 of geological survey of Pakistan. This block is comprised over the deposits (formed as a result of /weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of KohSuleman Range) of gravel that are replenished each year.

**b) Quality of mineral in the block:**

The mineral size in the block ranges from gravel to boulders mostly used in development work of irrigation department like pitching etc.

**c) Availability of access road to the block:**

This block is easily approachable from main Taunsa – TibbiQaisrani road that is linked with metaled road near TibiQaisrani and after travelling a distance of 20 km. This road is further linked with non-metaled road near vihowa village leading towards the block after traveling a distance about 10 km.

**d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the block:**

The major consumption market of this block are projects of Irrigation department, if any. Boulders from this block are mostly used in pitching purpose.

**e) Average excavated quantity of mineral from the block during last five years:**

**Gravel Block Rai Nala, District D. G. Khan**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:**

Gravel block Rai Nala over an area of 414.14 acres falls on Topo sheet 39 J/8 near Rai Nala in district D. G. Khan. **Gravel Block Sanghar(6+7), District Dera Ghazi Khan**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:**

Gravel block Sanghar(6+7) over an area of 491.79 acres located near Sanghar Nala in district Dera Ghazi Khan. Geologically it contains huge deposits of mineral, mainly consisting of grave/boulders, formed as a result of weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of Koh Suleman Range. It is situated on eastern side of Koh Suleman Range. Quantity of the mineral that is deposited varies with hill torrents. However, as per field observations from the old/current working pits, workable seam of gravel is about 13 feet in the leased area which is sufficient for above next 20-30 years. It falls on Topo sheet 39 J/10.

**b) Quality of mineral in the block:**

The mineral size in the block ranges from gravel to boulders, which is suitable for crushing plants and development work by irrigation department.

**c) Availability of access road to the block:**

A metal road about 8 km from Taunsa Sharif to Gulki via Mangrotha village leads to the block. About 1/2 Km kacha link road connects the block with main road.

**d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the block:**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:**

Gravel block Vadore-3 over an area of 413.22 acres located near village vadore at distance of 10 km in west of D. G. Khan city. Geologically, it contains deposits of gravel/boulders, formed as a result of weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of Koh Suleman Range. Each year, deposits are replenished by floods. It is situated on eastern side of koh Suleman Range in Vadore Nala, District D. G. Khan. **Ordinary Sand/Ghassar Taunsa Zone (Revised), District Dera Ghazi Khan**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of zone and assessment of mineral in the zone:**

This lease of Ordinary Sand/ghassar over an area of 17013.12 acres is located in Sanghar Nala that can be found under Sanghar Nala bridge on Indus Highway near Tounsa Sharif after travelling about 84 km from Dera Ghazi Khan towards Tounsa on Indus Highway. This zone is being granted since 2008 and bidding history is given separately. The northern & southern portion of the zone comprises of alluvial deposits whereas central part consists of fluvial deposits of Sanghar Nala that are replenished each year by hill torrents. At south of Tounsa Sharif, Sanghar Nala is located. Upper & lower portions of the zone consist of cultivable and privately owned lands.

**b) Quality of mineral in the zone:**

The zone contains sand and ghassar deposits with 3-4 feet alluvial over burden in alluvial terrain where as in Sanghar Nala fluvial sand deposits range from coarse to fine sand that is replenished each year by hill torrents.

**c) Availability of access road to the zone:**

This zone is located near Tounsa Sharif about 84 km away from Dera Ghazi Khan city on Indus Highway.

**d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the zone:**

The consumption markets of the mineral is Tounsa Sharif city and nearby villages for construction and filling purposes.

**a) Average excavated quantity of mineral from the zone during last five years:**

An average excavation during past 5 years cannot be assessed as no record in this regard is available with the office. However, as per observations during site inspection, an average excavation of sand is 30-40 trolleys per day.
