ORDINARY SAND KHURRIANWLA JAMYANA ZONE

a) Geological survey, location of the block and assessment of mineral in the zone.

Geologically this zone falls in agricultural lands and barren lands containing alluvial deposits of Ghassar/Bhassar. The Ghassar/Bhassar excavation from this zone is subject to consent of land owners. This zone is located along the Khurrianwala-Lahore road near Chak No.68 Jamyana and Khurrianwala City, Tehsil Jarranwala District Faisalabad. It covers an area of 23563.920 acres and falls on the Survey of Pakistan Topographic Sheet No. 44E/7. It only contains Ghassar/Bhassar, which is covered by a layer of 3-5 feet overburden of clay/soil. It only caters filling demand of local residential or industrial plots and some brick kilns therefore, there is no regular excavation or supply from this zone rather it is only operated when demand arises. The Bhassar/Ghassar deposits cannot be assessed by ordinary means, however, sufficient deposits of Bhassar/Ghassar are available to meet the requirement of filling of industrial or residential plot on demand.

b) Quality of minerals in the zone.

Only deposits of Ghassar/Bhassar is found in this zone. The quality of minerals is poor.

c) Availability of access road to the zone.

This zone is easily accessible through Khurrianwala-Lahore road, near Chak No. 68 Jamyana and Khurrianwala City.

d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the zone.

It only caters filling demand of local residential or industrial plots and some brick kilns therefore, there is no regular excavation or supply from this zone rather it is only operated when demand arises.

e) Average excavated quantity of minerals during last five years:

There is not regular supply from this zone. This zone becomes operative only when demand of Ghassar/Bhassar arises in local industry for filling purposes or filling of local plot. Other than that, there is no market for this zone. However, consumption of 20-25 trollies is expected from this Zone.

f) Future potential:

As per information available with this office, no new mega project is going to take place in the vicinity of this block, which could have considerable impact on demand of Bhassar/Ghassar from this block. Future potential of this block is expected same with variation of $\pm 10\%$.

ORDINARY SAND DULAY KI WEHNIWAL ZONE

a) Geological survey, location of the zone and assessment of mineral in the zone.

This zone is situated on District boundary of Sahiwal & Faisalabad and its located near Dulay ki wehniwal, Mamukanjan townon western bank of Ravi River. The proposed zone comprises over an area of 19078.42 acres which is marked on Topo Sheet No.44B/6 & 44B/10 of Survey of Pakistan. Sufficient quantity of fluvial sand deposits are available in the zone, which were deposited as bedload and suspended load by the water flow in Ravi River. Major portion of this zone falls in the bed of Ravi River where sand is available at surface but some portion of it also falls in common land where sand deposits are covered by a layer of two to three feet soil/clay.

b) Quality of the minerals in the zone.

This proposed zone mostly falls in the bed of Ravi River as well as in agriculture lands. Both fluvial and alluvial sand deposits of medium to good quality sand are abundantly available in this proposed zone.

c) Availability of access road to the zone.

This proposed zone can be easily accessed through Mamukanjan road. However, one to two kilometers Kacha road is also required to be maintained for its operation.

d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the zone.

The main market for this proposed zone is Mamukanjan town and surrounding villages, which are easily accessible through above mentioned roads. The Sand/Bhassar excavated from this proposed zone will be used for filling purpose, construction and bricks making. The mode of Sand/Bhassar supply is mostly through the tractor trollies.

e) Average excavated quantity of minerals from the zone during last five years.

An average excavation during past five years cannot be assessed accurately as no such record is available in this office. However, as per observations recorded during site inspections of, an average excavation of Sand/Bhassar from the old block Dulay ki wehniwal is about 30-35 trollies per day.

f) Future potential.

As per information of this office, no new mega project of construction with more demand of sand than usual is going to take place in near future so the future potential for excavation of sand is expected to remain same with variation of $\pm 10\%$.
