

**PROFILE OF ORDINARY SAND CHAK NO. 67/15 L / WAJHIAN WALA ZONE-1**  
**DISTRICT KHANEWAL**

**a) Geological Survey, Location of zone and assessment of mineral in the block:**

The mining lease of ordinary sand Chak No.67/15-L / WajhianWala Zone-1 over an area of 7262.89 acres is located in the eastern side of Sindhni Mailsi Link Cannal & on the boundary of Vehari-Khanewal in District Khanewal. It falls on the Survey of Pakistan topo sheet 44B/4 & 44B/8. Geologically the area of the zone falls in the old bed of Sutluj river as well as in agriculture lands. Fluvial type of sand deposits are present. Sand is not exposed on surface and is being excavated by removing over burden i.e. upper soil surface of 3-5 feet and pit of sand can be established with the consent of landowner.

**b) Quality of mineral in the block:**

Medium to good quality sand deposit are available in the zone area and mostly used for construction purpose.

**c) Availability of access road to the block:**

The area of Zone is accessible from Katcha khoh to Vehari road. The existing pit is approachable through 2 km from Katcha Khoh to Vehari metal road near Wajhian wala town. Furthermore sand can also be supplied to the Katcha Khoo town.

**d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the block:**

The main consumption market of this block is Wajhianwala town and its surrounding villages which are easily accessible from the pit of sand in leased area.

**e) Average excavated quantity of mineral from the zone during last five years:**

No production data of sand is available, however, as per observation during site visits average excavation of sand/ghassar is ranging from 10-12 trollies per day depending upon demand.

## **PROFILE OF ORDINARY SAND BASTI DULWAN ZONE, DISTRICT KHANEWAL**

### **a) Geological Survey, Location of zone and assessment of mineral in the zone:**

Mining lease for ordinary sand BastiDulwan over an area of 13306 acres is located in the north of Mianchannu city at distance of about 20km from Mianchannu city. Most of the area of the zone falls in bed of River Ravi. Geologically, this zone has fluvial deposits of sand/ ghassar which are replenished each year during flood. It falls on Topo sheet 44B/6.

### **b) Quality of mineral in the zone:**

Medium to good quality sand/gassar is available in the zone.

### **c) Availability of access road to the zone:**

A metalled road about 20 km from Mian Channu leads to Dulwan Basti from where about 2 km kacha road is required to be maintain to approach the sand deposits in the river bed.

### **d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the zone:**

Main consumption markets of this zone are Tulamba and Mian Channu city which are accessible from the pits of the sand in the lease area.

### **e) Average excavated quantity of mineral from the zone during last five years:**

No production data of sand is available, however, reportedly, an average excavation of sand is ranging from 25-30 trollies per day depending on demand.
