

Reserve Price of Sand/Gravel Berot Nala Zone, District Rajanpur

a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:

Sand/Gravel Berot Nala Zone over an area of 41888.66 acres falls on Topo sheet 39 G/16. The zone contains mineral deposits (formed as a result of weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of Koh Suleman Range) of inter mixed sand and gravel/boulders that are replenished by hill torrents. A metallic road (about 18km) from Rajanpur City goes to Farid Air Base from where and a kacha road about 14 km via BMP Post Kot Sabzal. From this post a kacha road about 12 km long in Pitokh Nala towards north leads Belab Nala where zone is situated. The mineral available is sufficient to meet the quantum of future excavation. It is located on eastern side of Koh Suleman range.

b) Quality of mineral in the block:

The mineral present in the zone ranges from medium sand to coarse sand and gravel to boulders.

c) Availability of access road to the block:

A metallic road (about 18km) from Rajanpur City goes to Farid Air Base from where and a kacha road about 14 km via BMP Post Kot Sabzal. From this post a kacha road about 12 long in Pitokh Nala towards north leads Belab Nala where zone is situated.

d) Accessibility to the market and consumption of the mineral in the block:

There is no consumption market of the mineral from this zone. However, it was used in the development projects of irrigation department.

OVER AN AREA OF 79654.03 ACRES, DISTRICT RAJANPUR**

a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:

Mining lease of ordinary sand over an area of 79654.03 acres is located near bara in district Rajanpur. It falls about 28 km away from Kashmor on Kashmor to sui road. Geologically, block contains deposits mainly consisting of gravel/boulder, formed as a result of weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of Koh Suleman Range. It is situated on eastern side of koh Suleman Range. As per field observations from the old/current working pits, workable seam of gravel is about 10 feet in the leased area which is sufficient for future excavation. It falls on Topo sheet 39 H/6

b) Quality of mineral in the block:

The mineral size in the block ranges from gravel to boulder which is suitable for crushing plants and development work of irrigation department.

c) Availability of access road to the block:

A metal road about 28 km from Kashmor to Sui (Balochistan) passes nearby the block.

a) Geological Survey, Location of block and assessment of mineral in the block:

Mining lease of Gravel block Shori Nala-2 is located near Shori in district Rajanpur. A kacha road about 9 km from railway crossing near Shah Wali (situated on Rajanpur-Kashmor road) and 4 km kacha road ahead in Shori Nala leads to the block. Geologically, block contains deposits of gravel formed as a result of weathering and erosion of rocks by hill torrents flowing downstream from hill sides of Koh Suleman Range.
