THE PUNJAB MINERS TRAINING INSTITUTIONS REGULATIONS, 1999

[27th October, 1999]

In exercise of the power conferred upon him under Section 29 of the Mines Act, 1923, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make the following Regulations:-

- **1.** (1) These Regulations may be called the Punjab Miners Training Institutions Regulations, 1999.
 - (2) They shall come into force at once.
 - (3) They shall extend to the whole of the Punjab.
- **2.** The Government or other persons may establish Institutes for imparting training to persons either employed or to be employed in mines.
- **3.** No private Institute shall be run except in accordance with these Regulations and unless it is registered by the Government on the recommendations of the Mining Board.
- **4.** The syllabi and curricula of the institutes shall be such as may be determined by the Government on the recommendations of the Mining Board.
- **5.** The Mining Board shall constitute a Management Committee for each Institute which shall advise the Heard of the Institutes in relation to its management.
- **6.** The Chief Inspector shall supervise the institute and shall keep the Mining Board informed about their performance.
- **7.** Without prejudice to the generality of clause 6 the Chief Inspector shall supervise the following matters:-
 - (a) The number of seats; their allocation for each course to be offered for admission in each Institute.
 - (b) The fee, securities and other charges to be paid by each student enrolled for a course.
 - (c) The Academic Calendar and Conduct Rules of the Institutes.
 - (d) The affiliation of institutes with universities, colleges and other centres of excellence within Pakistan and abroad.
 - (e) The staff strength whether on full time or part time basis required for the running of a course.
 - (f) The practical training of trainees enrolled in the Institutes.
 - (g) The placement qualified training in mining and industrial establishments.
 - (h) The minimum pay and allowances to be offered to successful trainees.
 - (i) The organization of refresher courses for groups of successful trainees
- **8.** Subject to the general supervision and control of the Chief Inspector the Head of an Institute shall perform the following functions:-
 - (a) Announce admissions through notice to the press at such time as may be prescribed by the Calendar.
 - (b) Arrange admission tests and interviews.
 - (c) Finalize the admissions.
 - (d) Arrange printing of prospectus.
 - (e) Frame Conduct Rules for the trainees.
 - (f) Exercise all administrative and financial powers as admissible for running the Institute.
 - (g) Constitute various committees.
 - (h) Arrange feed back regarding the performance of trainees to their parents.

- (i) Arrange liaison with the examining body for the registration; attendance and other certification of students.
- (j) Ensure submission of periodical reports on the administrative; financial and professional aspects of the Institute where necessary.
- (k) Assist the Management Committees and supervisory agencies on any matter relating to the improvement; up-gradation of curricula and other standards of the Institute.
